All the surplus income from Halton Lune Hydro will go to the Halton Lune Trust, a charitable organisation registered with the Charity Commission. The Trust will distribute these profits for public benefit via a grant application process at their discretion within and around the Parish of Halton with Aughton in line with the Trust Objectives, and under Charity Commission rules.

Grants will favour activities that encourage the social involvement of all individuals and voluntary groups within the community in the following ways (but not limited to):

- Improving and enhancing recreational opportunities and sporting activities
- Supporting energy associated measures delivery energy efficiency and carbon reducing technologies
- Promotion of conservation and enhancement of the natural environment for the benefit of the community
- Promotion of conservation, protection and improvement of land, buildings, other structures and artefacts of particular historic, architectural, archaeological or cultural significance.

Grants can be awarded to recognised non profit making organisations and groups based in and around the parish or benefiting the parish of Halton with Aughton. It is considered that those organisations and groups having a postal address within the rural areas named on the OS Map surrounding the parish qualify for consideration, i.e. Slyne, Nether Kellet, Over Kellet, Gressingham, Hornby, Farleton, Claughton, Caton Green, Brookhouse, Caton and Denny Beck. Applications received from organisations and groups based in the parish of Halton and Aughton will be prioritised. The Trust does not consider applications from businesses or individuals.
